On selection, brings the user to 01.02.Select_Arrival_Airport screen

On selection, brings the user to 01.03.Add_Passengers screen

The default to the button is to be set to return

- The user can select the one way button which removes the "Fly back" option

On selection, brings the user to 01.04. Calender_Choose_Fly_Out_Date

-The user cannot select a "Fly Back" date unless they have choosen a "Fly Out" date

On selection, the user will only be given direct flight options in the 02.01.Choose_Departure_Flight

On selection, all fields are validated

- If the validation is unsuccessful, errors will appear

-Errors will only appear if one of the fields are empty

-If the validation is successful, the user is brought to 02.01.Choose_Departure_Flight screen

- Error messages should be shown underneath the empty field (i.e. "Please choose destination to

30% transparency on unavaiable dates

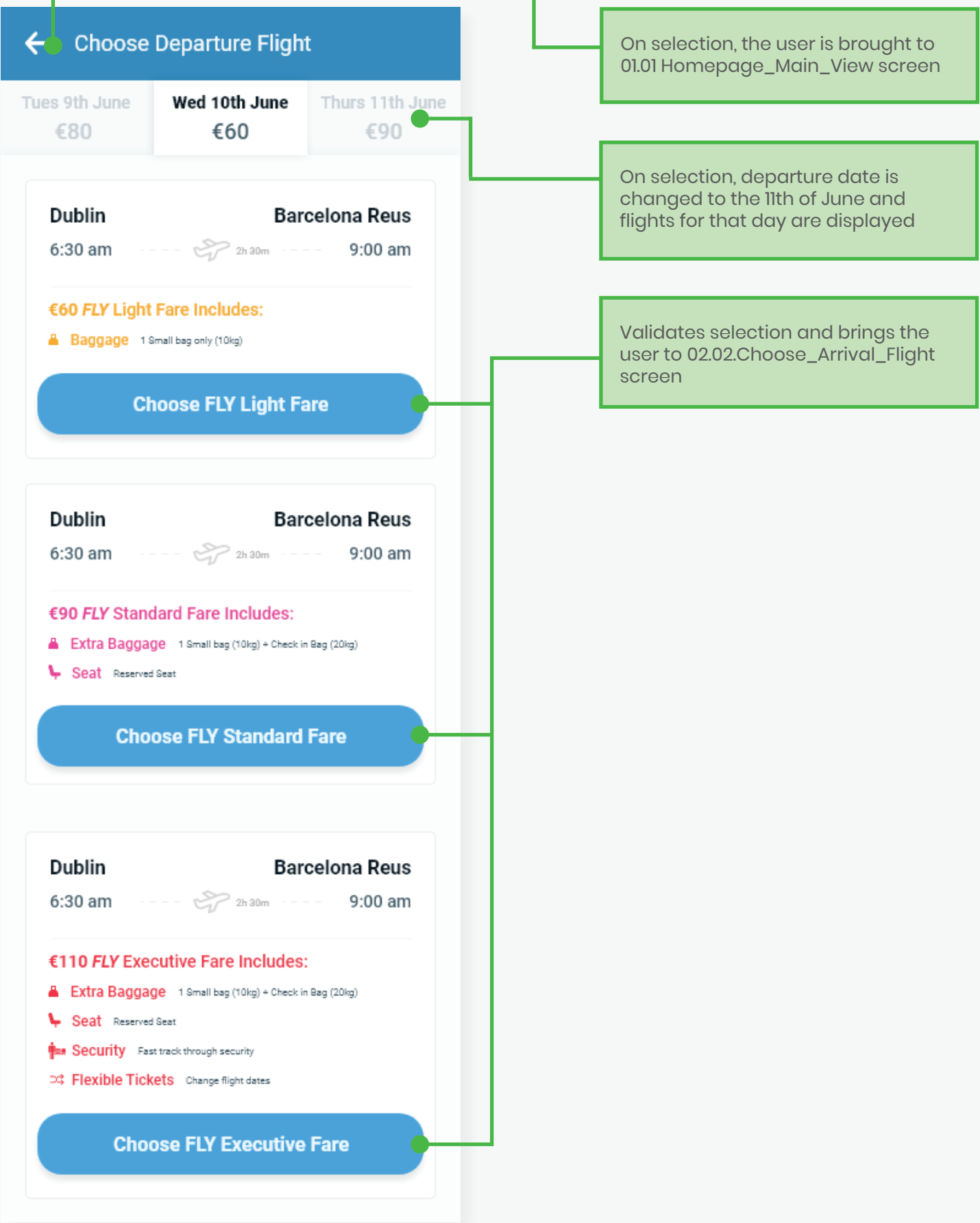

03.01 Enter_Passenger_Details

On selection, the user is brought to 02.02.Choose_Arrival_Flight screen

Steps indicate how far into the booking process the user is

Drop-down appears to allow the user to select their preferred title

On selection, QWERTY keyboard appears to allow the user to put in their requested information

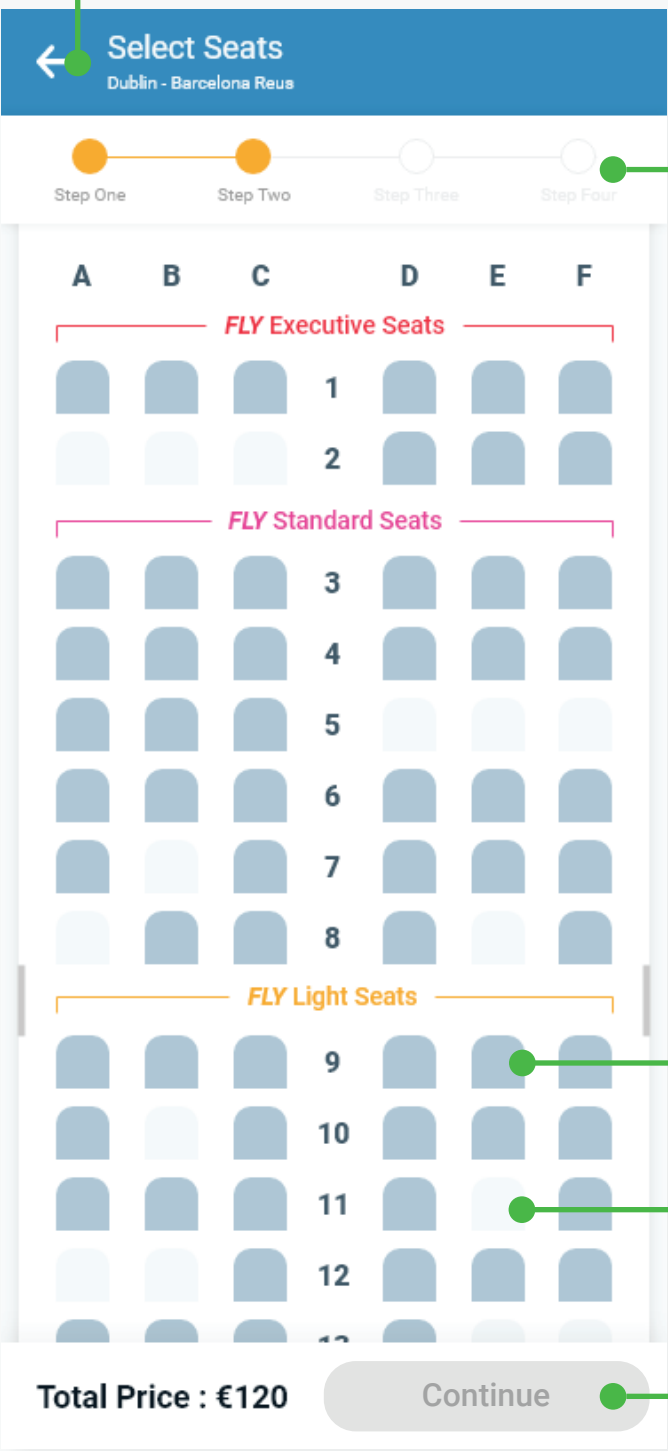
-Clearly defines input from the user by darkening the input text (*First Name*) and has a transparency on the input placeholders(*Surname, Email*)

On selection, an email optimised QWERTY keyboard appears to allow the user to put in their email address

On selection, all fields are validated

- If the validation is unsuccessful, errors will appear underneath the empty field (i.e. "Please enter a valid email address")
- If the validation is successful, the user is brought to 04.01.Seat_Select screen

04.01 Seat_Select



On selection, the user is brought to 03.01.Enter_Passenger_Details screen

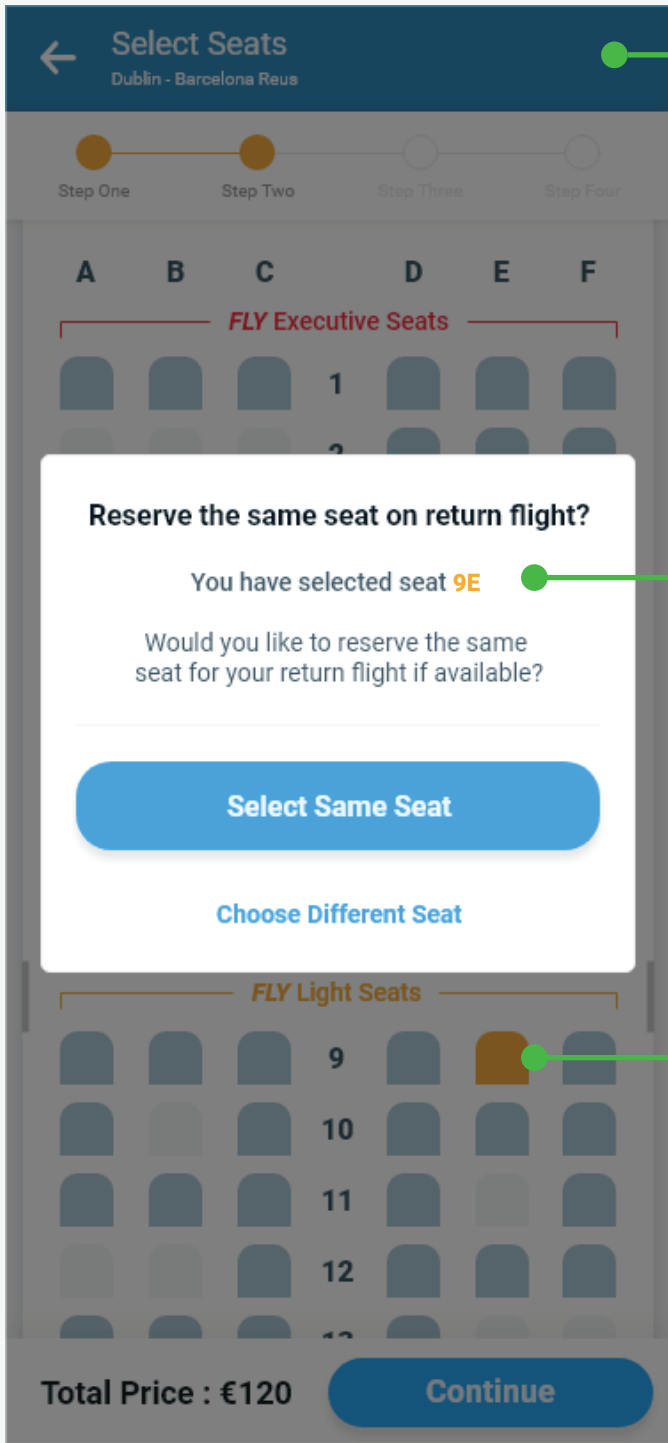
Steps indicate how far into the booking process the user is

On selection, the selected seat highlights and a pop up appears asking the user if they would like the same seat for returning flight as seen in 04.02.Seat_Select_Pop_Up

-Seat selection is made clear by having a transparency on the already taken seats

The continue but is disabled and the user cannot progress without selecting a seat

04.02 Seat_Select_Pop_Up



Overlay disables the user from interacting with anything else on the screen but the pop up

Pop up appears once the user has selected a seat, telling the user which seat they have selected and asking if they want the same seat for the return flight

-If the user selects “Select the same Seat”, they are brought to the Payment Screen

-If the user selected “Choose Different Seat”, they are brought back to 04.01.Seat_Select screen where the continue button is now interactable

-The continue button will bring the user to the Select Return Seats screen
